

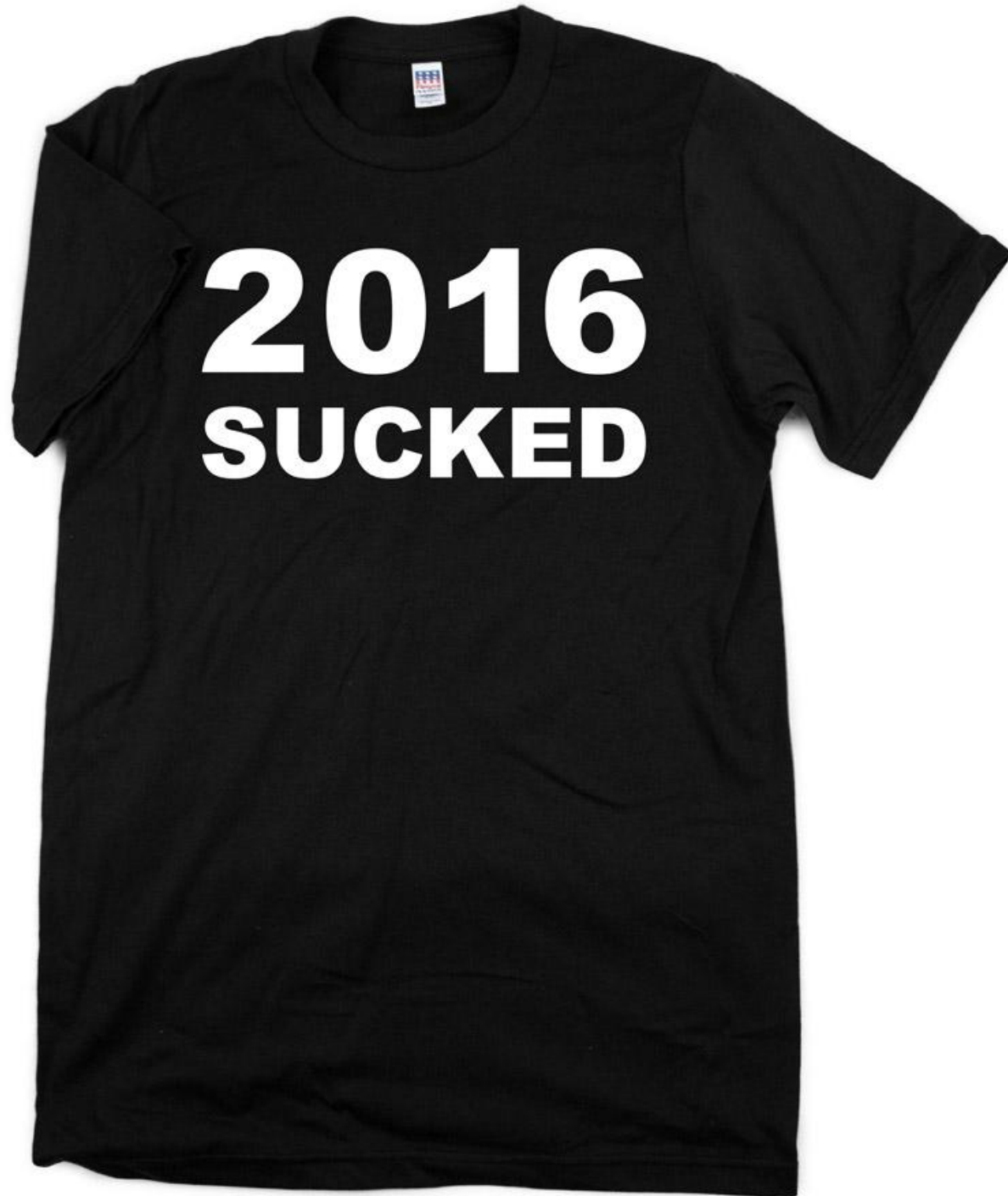

- A range of transformative programs enabled by working at a very large scale.

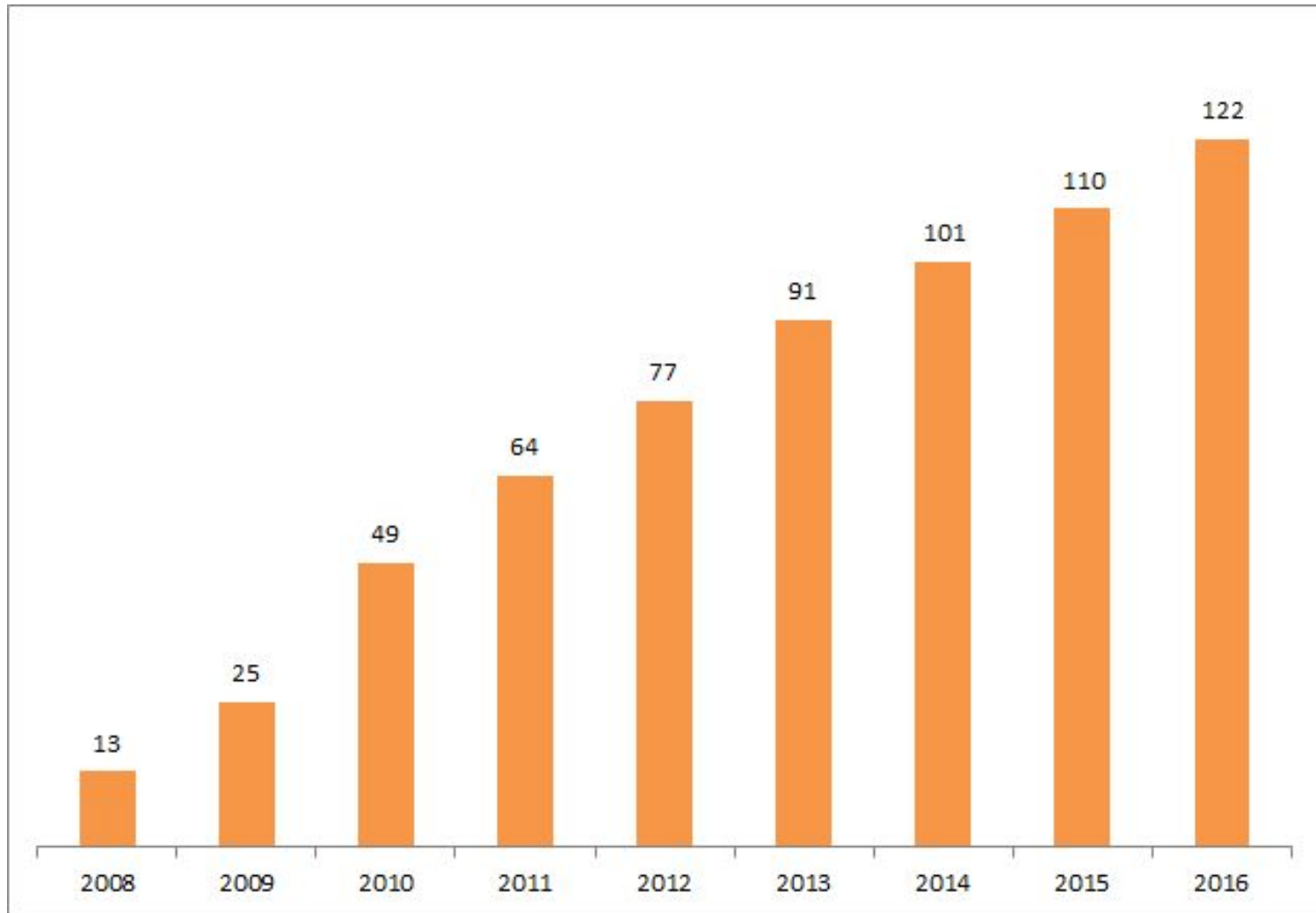

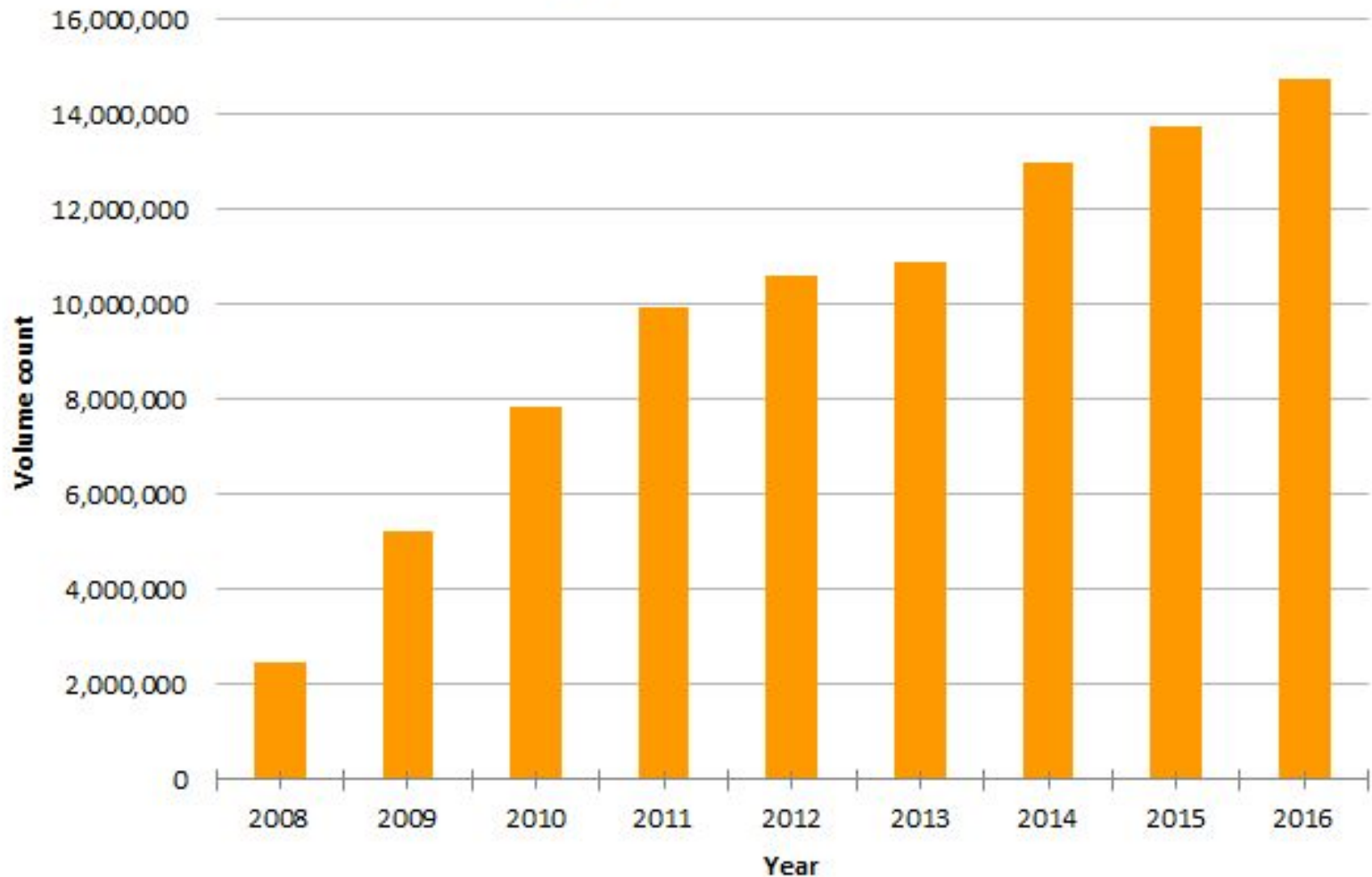

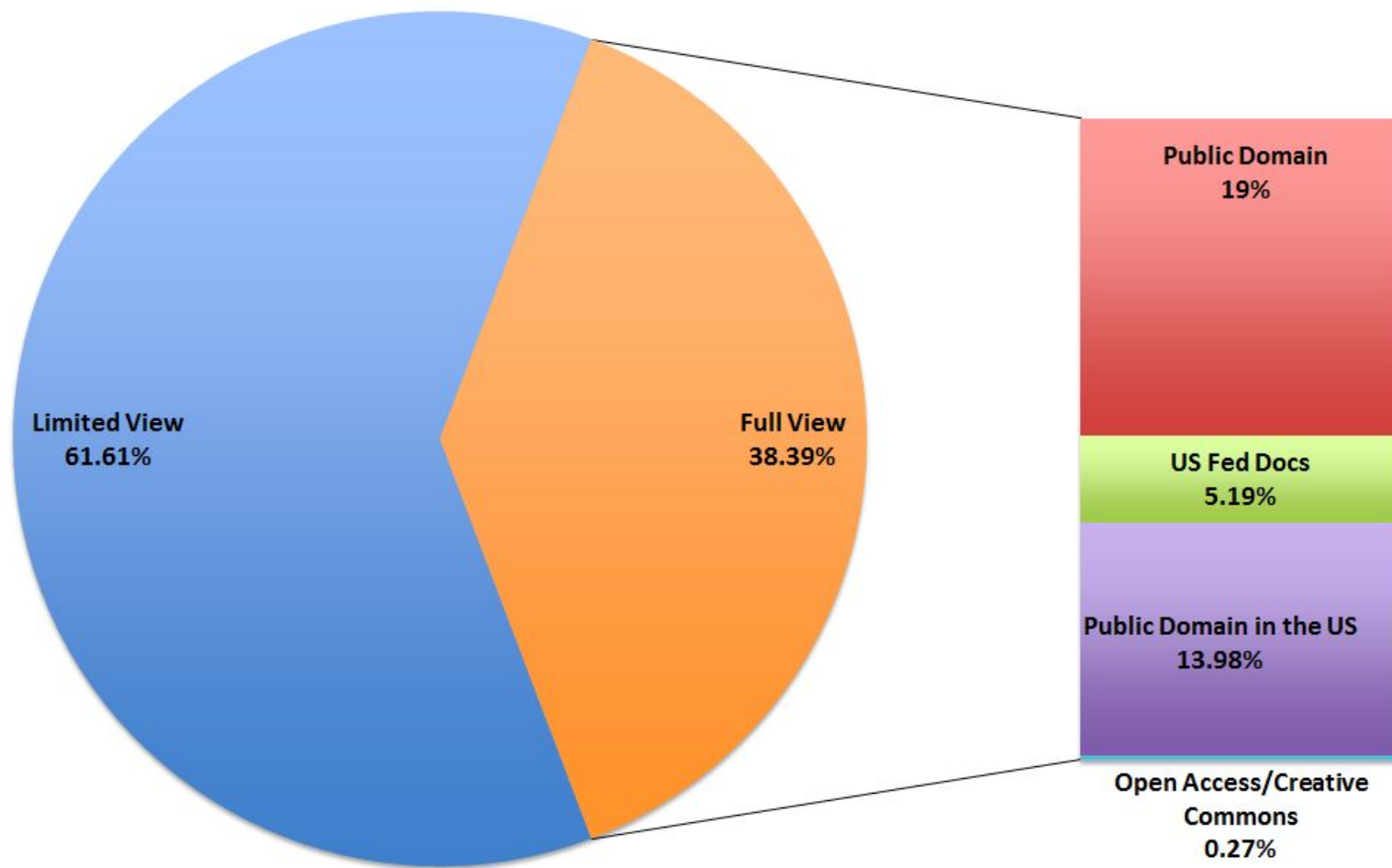

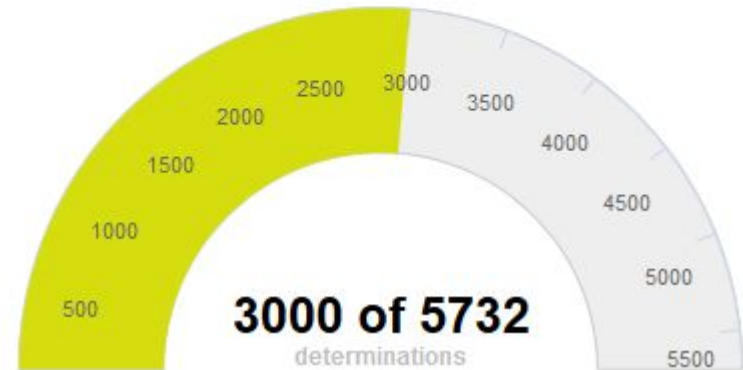

Policy change: Print disabled users may access anything in the collection, not just what their library owns.

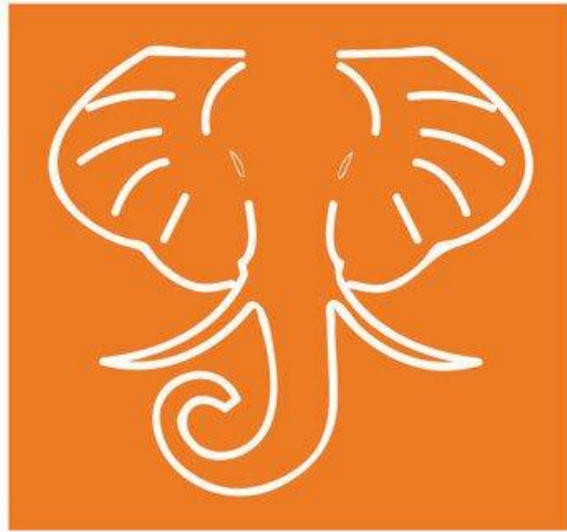
