HathiTrust Federal Documents Advisory Committee, June 2021

The [HathiTrust Federal Documents Advisory Committee](#) has created this side-by-side chart as a reference for our HathiTrust member libraries and to promote greater understanding of synergies and complementary features between [HathiTrust](#) and the [U.S. Government Publishing Office](#) (GPO) [Federal Depository Library Program](#) (FDLP). The chart provides a high-level summary in terms of organization, policies, content and collections, preservation, access, and services related to published U.S. Federal Documents.
