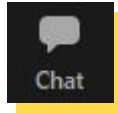

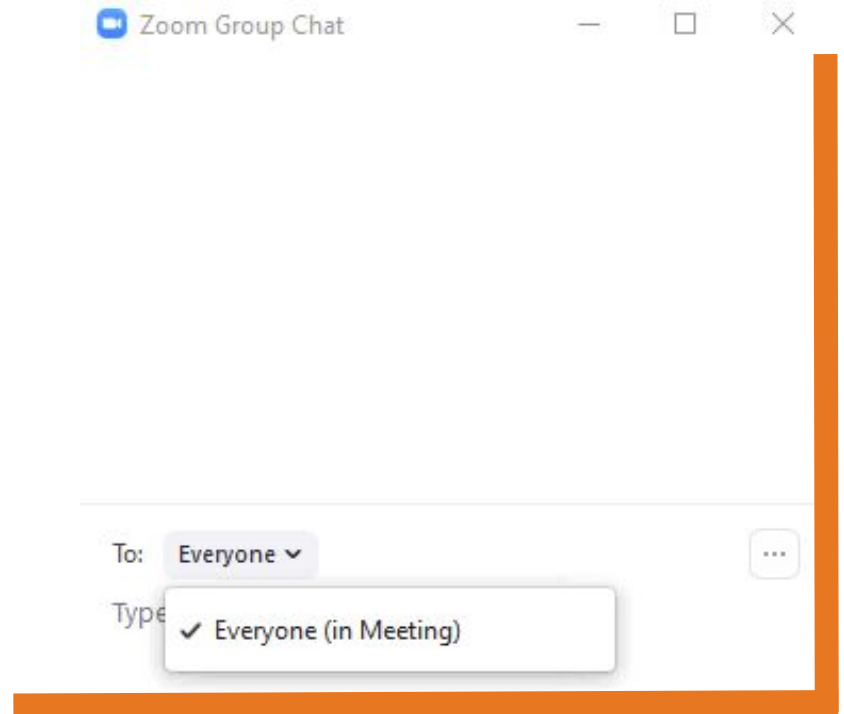
# Chat

- Language follows local collection proportions

# ETAS Findings - Data



- 1.2M titles in ETAS for Duke, 6,871 (0.58%) titles used
- 68% (4,564) → 1 view and 0 renewals
- 45 titles used over 10+ times
- 13% of used titles were checked out physically pre-ETAS

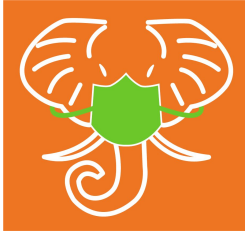
Local Action?
